Material Safety Data Sheet for <u>Purified Bordetella pertussis filamentous</u> haemagglutinin (FHA)

SECTION I - BIOLOGICAL SAMPLE

NAME: Purified Bordetella pertussis filamentous haemagglutinin (FHA)

CHARACTERISTICS: Sample is of biological origin and is presented as a white lyophilized solid in a glass vial. Each vial contains no more than 1mg. Additional components present are 0.05M tris-HCl buffer at pH8, 0.5M sodium chloride and 5% sucrose.

SECTION II - HEALTH HAZARD

Main Hazard: Cell adhesin, illicits an immune response

Health Effects: - Eyes: Unknown

Skin: Unknown

Ingestion: Illicits immune response Inhalation: Illicits immune response

SECTION III - MEDICAL

FIRST AID/TREATMENT:

Eyes: Flush with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. Assure adequate flushing by separating eyelids with fingers. Contact physician immediately.

Skin: Flush with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Contact physician immediately.

Ingestion: Wash out mouth with water provided that the person is conscious. Contact physician immediately.

Inhalation: Take in fresh air, if breathing becomes difficult. Contact physician immediately.

SECTION IV - RECOMMENDED PRECAUTIONS

LABORATORY CONTROL MEASURES: Good Laboratory Practice should be observed.

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION: None required **HAND PROTECTION:** Latex or nitrile gloves **EYE PROTECTION:** Safety spectacles/goggles

SECTION V - HANDLING & STORAGE INFORMATION

HANDLING: Can be used on bench, handle with gloves.

DISPOSAL: Dispose as clinical waste. Can be inactivated by heating to 100°C for 30 minutes.

STABLITY: May lose stability if not kept refrigerated
