**Description:** Respiratory Syncytial Virus Type B (RSV-B, Strain CH93 (18)-18) is an enveloped Paramyxovirus that contains a helical nucleocapsid and negative-sense, single-stranded linear RNA.

**Purification:** This virus is purified from Vero cells using sucrose density gradient ultracentrifugation, disrupted in the presence of 0.5% Triton X-100 non-ionic detergent/0.6 M KCl, and heat inactivated.

**Inactivation:** Viral inactivation is verified for every lot of lysate by the absence of viral growth in validated tissue culture-based infectivity assays.

**Health and Safety:** Respiratory Syncytial Virus is a Biosafety Level 2 organism. Use universal precautions when handling this product. Viral lysate has been treated by a method validated to be effective for virus inactivation. However, no method can be guaranteed 100% effective. This material should be handled as if capable of transmitting infectious agents.

**Amount:** 0.1 mg / 0.5 mg

**Buffer:** 0.5% Triton X-100 non-ionic detergent/0.6 M KCl
